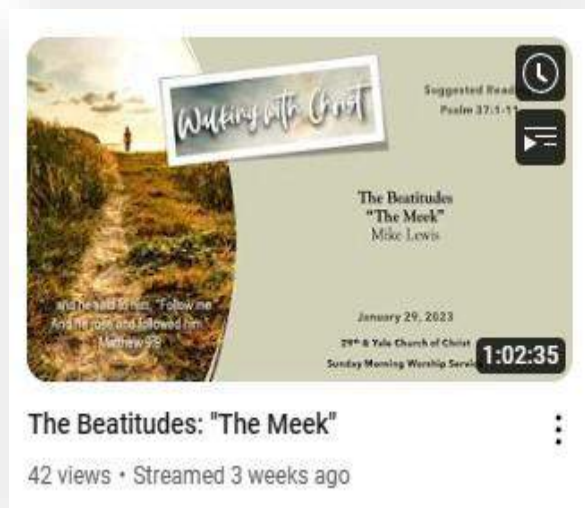
# Weekly Scripture

## II Timothy 3:10-17 (ESV)

<sup>10</sup> You, however, have followed my teaching, my conduct, my aim in life, my faith, my patience, my love, my steadfastness, <sup>11</sup> my persecutions and sufferings that happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, and at Lystra—which persecutions I endured; yet from them all the Lord rescued me. <sup>12</sup> Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, <sup>13</sup> while evil people and impostors will go on from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. <sup>14</sup> But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it <sup>15</sup> and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

## CHRIST IS PREACHED I REJOICE PHILIPPIANS 1:18



**3.12.23 – “Christian Baptism 1”**  
In this first lesson we will explore what the Bible teaches about baptism found in the gospel accounts and in the book of Acts. Our task in this series is to learn and to practice the will of God in baptism.

(NKJ) Romans 10:8-13

<sup>8</sup> But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach): <sup>9</sup> that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. <sup>11</sup> For the Scripture says, “Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.” <sup>12</sup> For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. <sup>13</sup> For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.”

(NKJ) Luke 4:1-13

<sup>4</sup> Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, <sup>2</sup> being tempted for forty days by the devil. And in those days He ate nothing, and afterward, when they had ended, He was hungry. <sup>3</sup> And the devil said to Him, “If You are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread.” <sup>4</sup> But Jesus answered him, saying, “**It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.’**” <sup>5</sup> Then the devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. <sup>6</sup> And the devil said to Him, “All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. <sup>7</sup> Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours.” <sup>8</sup> And Jesus answered and said to him, “**Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, ‘You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.’**” <sup>9</sup> Then he brought Him to Jerusalem, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, “If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here. <sup>10</sup> For it is written: ‘He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you,’ <sup>11</sup> and, ‘In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.’” <sup>12</sup> And Jesus answered and said to him, “**It has been said, ‘You shall not tempt the Lord your God.’**” <sup>13</sup> Now when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from Him until an opportune time.
