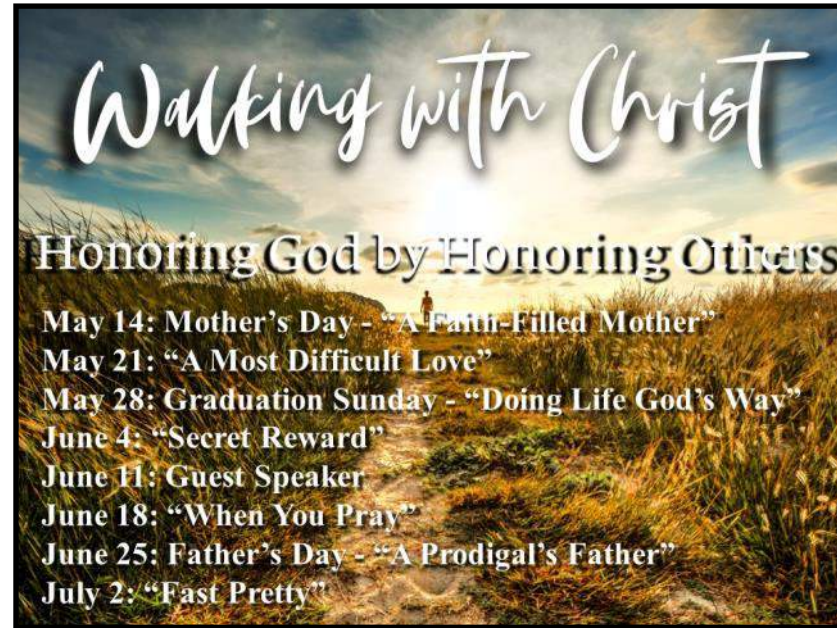

Proverbs 31:10-31 (ESV)

- <sup>10</sup> An excellent wife who can find?  
She is far more precious than jewels.
- <sup>11</sup> The heart of her husband trusts in her,  
and he will have no lack of gain.
- <sup>12</sup> She does him good, and not harm,  
all the days of her life.
- <sup>13</sup> She seeks wool and flax,  
and works with willing hands.
- <sup>14</sup> She is like the ships of the merchant;  
she brings her food from afar.
- <sup>15</sup> She rises while it is yet night  
and provides food for her household  
and portions for her maidens.
- <sup>16</sup> She considers a field and buys it;  
with the fruit of her hands she plants a  
vineyard.
- <sup>17</sup> She dresses herself with strength  
and makes her arms strong.
- <sup>18</sup> She perceives that her merchandise is profitable.  
Her lamp does not go out at night.
- <sup>19</sup> She puts her hands to the distaff,  
and her hands hold the spindle.
- <sup>20</sup> She opens her hand to the poor  
and reaches out her hands to the needy.
- <sup>21</sup> She is not afraid of snow for her household,  
for all her household are clothed in scarlet.
- <sup>22</sup> She makes bed coverings for herself;  
her clothing is fine linen and purple.
- <sup>23</sup> Her husband is known in the gates  
when he sits among the elders of the land.
- <sup>24</sup> She makes linen garments and sells them;  
she delivers sashes to the merchant.
- <sup>25</sup> Strength and dignity are her clothing,  
and she laughs at the time to come.
- <sup>26</sup> She opens her mouth with wisdom,  
and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue.
- <sup>27</sup> She looks well to the ways of her household  
and does not eat the bread of idleness.
- <sup>28</sup> Her children rise up and call her blessed;  
her husband also, and he praises her:
- <sup>29</sup> “Many women have done excellently,  
but you surpass them all.”
- <sup>30</sup> Charm is deceitful, and beauty is vain,  
but a woman who fears the LORD is to be  
praised.
- <sup>31</sup> Give her of the fruit of her hands,  
and let her works praise her in the gates.

(NKJ) Matthew 22:34-40

<sup>34</sup> But when the Pharisees  
heard that He had silenced  
the Sadducees, they  
gathered together. <sup>35</sup> Then  
one of them, a lawyer,  
asked *Him a question*,  
testing Him, and saying,  
<sup>36</sup> “Teacher, which is the  
great commandment in the  
law?”

<sup>37</sup> Jesus said to him, “**You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.**” <sup>38</sup> This is the first and great commandment. <sup>39</sup> And the second is like it: **‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’** <sup>40</sup> On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.”

(NKJ) Acts 11:1-18

<sup>11</sup> Now the apostles and brethren who were in Judea heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God. <sup>2</sup> And when Peter came up to Jerusalem, those of the circumcision contended with him, <sup>3</sup> saying, “You went in to uncircumcised men and ate with them!”

<sup>4</sup> But Peter explained *it* to them in order from the beginning, saying: <sup>5</sup> “I was in the city of Joppa praying; and in a trance I saw a vision, an object descending like a great sheet, let down from heaven by four corners; and it came to me. <sup>6</sup> When I observed it intently and considered, I saw four-footed animals of the earth, wild beasts, creeping things, and birds of the air. <sup>7</sup> And I heard a voice saying to me, ‘**Rise, Peter; kill and eat.**’ <sup>8</sup> But I said, ‘Not so, Lord! For nothing common or unclean has at any time entered my mouth.’ <sup>9</sup> But the voice answered me again from heaven, ‘**What God has cleansed you must not call common.**’ <sup>10</sup> Now this was done three times, and all were drawn up again into heaven. <sup>11</sup> At that very moment, three men stood before the house where I was, having been sent to me from Caesarea. <sup>12</sup> Then the Spirit told me to go with them, doubting nothing. Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered the man’s house. <sup>13</sup> And he told us how he had seen an angel standing in his house, who said to him, ‘Send men to Joppa, and call for Simon whose surname is Peter,’ <sup>14</sup> who will tell you words by which you and all your household will be saved.’ <sup>15</sup> And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them, as upon us at the beginning. <sup>16</sup> Then I remembered the word of the Lord, how He said, ‘**John indeed baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit.**’ <sup>17</sup> If therefore God gave them the same gift as *He gave* us when we believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?”

<sup>18</sup> When they heard these things they became silent; and they glorified God, saying, “Then God has also granted to the Gentiles repentance to life.”
