(NKJ) Titus 3:3-7

³ For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another. ⁴ But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, ⁵ not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, ⁶ whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior, ⁷ that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

(NKJ) John 6:26-32

²⁶ Jesus answered them and said, “**Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled.** ²⁷ **Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him.**”

²⁸ Then they said to Him, “What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?”

²⁹ Jesus answered and said to them, “**This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent.**”

³⁰ Therefore they said to Him, “What sign will You perform then, that we may see it and believe You? What work will You do?”

³¹ Our fathers ate the manna in the desert; as it is written, ‘He gave them bread from heaven to eat.’”

³² Then Jesus said to them, “**Most assuredly, I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread from heaven.**”
